

## Army Corp of Engineers Guidelines

### Dock Removal, New Dock Construction and Boat Ramp Installation

As long as he stays within the limits of our NWP 36, for Boat Ramps, he is pre-authorized and does not need to send in an application for a permit. Here are the parameters:

1. The discharge does within the water (i.e. below the ordinary high water mark of the lake), cannot exceed 50 cubic yards of material.
2. The boat ramp does not exceed 20 feet in width.
3. The base material must be crushed stone, gravel, or other suitable material.
4. Excavation is limited to that necessary to prepare the site for construction and all excavated material is disposed of in uplands.
5. No material is placed in a wetland.

Note: The use of unsuitable material that is structurally unstable is not authorized.

Note 2: The excavation provision above allows the use of machinery that would scrape material inside the water, or push material around. As we discussed previously excavation done from top or bank, by scooping or vacuuming material out, does not require a permit.

Removing and replacing the dock does not require a permit from us.
